WHETHER

WESTERN DUALISM

BIBLICAL WHOLISM (the Whole Person Paradigm)

WESTERN DUALISM

involves an "Either / Or" compartmentalization of:

1. MIND & BODY

2. SPIRIT & MATTER

3. INDIVIDUAL & COMMUNITY

WHOLISM

> involves a "Both / And"

Integration of the whole person in environment

20th & 21st CENTURY SHIFTS TO WHOLISM

- Growing "Holistic Healing" practices
- More denominations and medical schools acknowledge faith and health link.
- Yet a true Whole Person approach fully integrating :
- Christian spirituality and healthcare
- Individual and community wellbeing is still more the exception

PROBLEMS OF TRADITIONAL WESTERN COMPARTMENTALIZATION

Physical healthcare a concern for *Physicians only*



Mental healthcare a concern for psychologist only



Thus HEALTH and SALVATION are



PROBLEMS OF TRADITIONAL WESTERN COMPARTMENTALIZATION

HEALTH = PHYSICAL PERFECTION (Materialism)

Hospitals are too often "factories"?

SALVATION = COMFORT of "SOUL" OR "SPIRIT" + MORALITY

Churches too often "theatres"?

The rest of the person is ignored by either

THE RESULTING CRISIS:

A "PATCHWORK APPROACH" IN HEALTH AND SPIRITUAL CARE:

- Marginalized poor:
 - disenfranchised from wellness
 - highest burden of diseases, violent injuries, deaths

THE RESULTING CRISIS: A "PATCHWORK APPROACH" IN HEALTH AND SPIRITUAL CARE:

- > Global lifestyle diseases epidemic
- > Common depression from isolation and loss of meaning
- Commercialisation and spiritual neglect in healthcare
- Creation destruction

based on BIBLICAL WHOLISM

BIBLICAL WHOLISM

(OR WHOLE PERSON WORLD VIEW)

based on a rediscovery of Biblical teachings. e.g:

"Preach the Kingdom" "Heal the sick" (Luke2:9)

"May the God who gives us peace make you holy in every way and keep <u>your whole being</u> – spirit, soul and body- free from every fault at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ" (I Thessalonians 5:23 NEV)

"Yet there was the hope that <u>creation would be one day</u> set free from it's slavery and decay and would share the glorious freedom of the sons of God" (Romans 8:20-21 TEV)

THE BIBLICALWHOLE PERSON PARADIGM: WHAT IS HEALTH?



Health is wholeness or harmony between:

- aspects of the self (mind, body and spirit)
- self and others, and in addition
- self and the natural environment
- self and God (as our centre)

Mutual interaction between all dimensions

THE BIBLICALWHOLE PERSON PARADIGM: WHAT IS SALVATION?

Compare western influenced view: legalistic & compartmentalized

Sin equals "A LACK OF MORALITY" causing CONDEMNATION OF THE SOUL

Salvation means only MORAL TRANSFORMATION and REDEMPTION OF THE <u>SOUL</u>

(regardless of state of body, mind or social welfare)

THE BIBLICAL WHOLE PERSON PARADIGM WHAT IS SALVATION? CONTD.

Compare western influenced view:

Sin involves Alienation from God due to Rebellion

Disintegration of self and relationships, which is Disease

THE BIBLICAL WHOLE PERSON PARADIGM WHAT IS SALVATION? CONTD.

According to the Biblical view:

Salvation involves:

Forgiveness of rebellion --- leading to

Reconciliation from alienation between

- persons and God;
- persons and each other --- leading to

Re-integration of the whole self and relationships*




